

## ZOE WHITE 2023

**TECHNICAL PRESENTATION:**

**Category:** White

**Classification:** Varietal wine

**Grape Varieties:** 70% Roditis Alepou, 30% Moscofilero

**Vineyards:** Roditis Alepou: mountain vineyards in the Peloponnese at a 1,476ft of altitude, Moscofilero: mountain vineyards in Mantinia at a 2,460ft of altitude

**Main type of soil:** Sandy

**Age of vines (average):** Roditis Alepou: 34 years, Moscofilero: 29 years

**Yields:** Roditis Alepou: 65 hl/ha, Moscofilero: 63 hl/ha

**Harvest dates:** Roditis Alepou: Beginning to middle of September, Moscofilero: End of September - beginning of October

**Alcohol:** 12%

**Total acidity:** 6.20 g/l

**pH:** 3.34

**Vinification/Maturation:** Skin contact for 3-6h at 14°C. Alcoholic fermentation in stainless steel vats at 16°C. Short ageing over fine lees. Screw cap.

**Tasting notes:** The colour is bright white-yellow with green hues. The nose is complex and the wine exudes aromas of fresh flowers, with hints of crushed blossoms. A relaxed pace and a luxurious texture give flavors of citrus fruits and touches of jasmine and mint. In the aftertaste, the acidity travels across the palate for a clean, extended finish.
