Vinification/Maturation: Skin contact for 3-6h at 14°C. Alcoholic fermentation in stainless steel vats at 16°C. Short ageing over fine lees. Screw cap.

Tasting notes: The colour is bright white-yellow with green hues. The nose is complex and the wine exudes aromas of fresh flowers, with hints of crushed blossoms. A relaxed pace and a luxurious texture give flavors of citrus fruits and touches of jasmine and mint. In the aftertaste, the acidity travels across the palate for a clean, extended finish.
